In this building, the habit of a family of several generations to live under the same roof has been carried on to the present day. The aim was to secure the independence of the family within the city, while providing a controlled relationship with the immediate

surroundings.
The garden floor houses the common gathering spaces for the entire family. On this floor where the main entrance is also located, the handicapped member of the family lives with his nuclear family; so the interiors of this floor were arranged to ergonomically respond to his special meeds. The three daughters of the family live on the first floor; parents on the second; and on the top floor are an assential to the proper of the prope

The design is the result of experimentations with spatial or organization within the building, façade decisions based on individual comfort of the users and the identity of the building, direct and indirect relations with the surroundings and typical character of an individual residential block.
